ORDINANCE NUMBER 1015

INTRODUCED BY ALDERMAN ALAN BELL

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NEW BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN WARD  
1 AND WARD 2 IN THE CITY OF NEW HAVEN; THEREBY REPEALING  
ORDINANCE 837 AND ANY AND ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT  
THEREWITH

WHEREAS, Ordinance 837 previously set out a boundary line between Ward 1 and Ward 2 in the City of New Haven, thereby determining and defining the area to be included in each ward; and

WHEREAS, the total population and registered voter count in each ward has changed since passage and approval of Ordinance 837, and the Board of Aldermen desires to revise said boundary line between wards in an effort to make the population and registered voter count in each ward approximately equal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE Board of Aldermen of the City of New Haven, Missouri, as follows:

SECTION ONE. That there shall be established within the City of New Haven two (2) wards which shall be divided as follows:

A. Ward One. All that part of the City lying west of a line beginning at the Missouri River, thence south on a line between lots 16 and 17 in Labar's addition to the City of New Haven to Main Street, thence across lot 19 to and continue south along the line between lots 5, 6, 9 and 10 of said addition to Front Street, thence south to the centerline of Front Street, thence west to the intersection of the centerline of Front Street and Olive Street, then south along the centerline of Olive Street to the intersection of the centerlines of Olive Street and Locust Street, thence east along the centerline of Locust Street to the intersection of the centerlines of Locust Street and McNair Street, thence south along the centerline of McNair Street to the intersection of the centerlines of McNair and Kemp Street, thence south along the centerline of Kemp Street to the termination of Kemp Street, thence south along the west line of Lot 9 of EB Hammacks' 3<sup>rd</sup> addition to the City of New Haven to a point at the southwest corner of said Lot 9, thence continuing south along the west line of a Part of Lot 9 of EB Hammack's 3<sup>rd</sup> addition to the City of New Haven to the southwest corner of said Part of Lot 9, thence south to the centerline of Mary Hammack Street, thence east along the centerline of Mary Hammack Street to the intersection of the centerlines of Mary Hammack and Short Street, thence south along the centerline of Short Street to the intersection of the centerlines of Short Street and Melrose Street, thence west along the centerline of Melrose Street to the intersection of the centerlines of Melrose Street and Douglas Street, thence south

along the centerline of Douglas Street to the intersection of the centerlines of Douglas Street and Missouri Route 100, thence west along the centerline of Missouri Route 100 to the west City limit line.

B. Ward Two. All that part of the City of New Haven, Missouri, lying east of Ward One.

SECTION TWO. Ordinance 837 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION THREE. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the 14<sup>th</sup> day of November 2011.
