

Public Hearing Notice

The City of New Haven, Missouri will hold a public hearing on Monday, December 13, 2021 at 6:30 p.m. at the New Haven Public Works Facility, located at 205 Industrial Drive in New Haven, Missouri 63068 to discuss the city's submission of the Community Development Block Grant Program application for the community. New Haven is interested in obtaining all citizens' input on community development needs within the city. As part of the hearing process, citizens will be asked to verbally assist in the completion of a Needs Assessment document. The document will detail what the residents feel are the strengths and weaknesses of the community. The city needs as much local participation as possible in order to reflect the true desires of the community as a whole, as well as the comments relating to the proposed project application. The State has established a maximum application request for each funding category. Activities that are eligible for funding include the improvement of public works, public facilities, housing rehabilitation, and others allowed by law. At least 51% of the funds must be used to benefit low-and-moderate income persons. No displacement of persons will be proposed.

The city is proposing to replace city streets, including Elton Street, Maiden Lane, and Circle Drive. The area to be addressed is Circle Drive, between Maupin Avenue and Highway 100, Elton Street between Circle Drive and Miller Street, and Maiden Lane between Miller Street and Maupin Avenue. The total project cost is estimated at \$806,352.10. The City of New Haven proposes to contribute \$102,722.04 in cash, \$203,630.06 in-kind labor, with grant funds of \$500,000 needed to make up the balance. All citizens, including those in the targeted area, are encouraged to attend in order to comment on the proposed activities.
